

Seeking Film Buffs to Join a Group on Film Appreciation



Are you a film buff, or maybe somebody who just likes to watch films and talk about what you've seen? If so, would you be interested in joining a new Lincoln u3a group?

Sue Firth (Vice Chair and Webmaster) and Sarah Hawley (Groups Co-Ordinator) are proposing to set up a monthly group to run along the lines of a traditional reading group, but for films instead of books.

Each month one of the group would suggest a film for everyone to watch on one of the free streaming services (iPlayer, ITVX, YouTube, etc) and then the group would discuss the film at the next meeting. The person who had chosen the film could do a little background research to help them lead the group discussion. The areas looked at might, for example, be related to the genre of the film, the influences on the director, other similar films, the career of the leading actors – basically whatever they feel would be of interest.

The meetings will take place at Sarah's house in Lincoln. The day and time of the monthly meetings can be agreed by the initial group members before the first meeting.
